MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 1984 MEETING

Andy LCZ referred to some vandalism that recently occurred to the Pt. Elgin repeater and repairs were being undertaken.

Jim BFV reminded the members that the cost of call letter licence plates was being reduced from \$100.00 to \$25.00.

Fred KPK requested and received some advice on correcting a fuse blowing problem in his Kenwood TR7.

Jim CRV received moderate response on staging a Xmas party and agreed to pursue the matter further.

It was suggested that we consider a change in the time of our Sunday morning net, but all agreed to keep the time and frequency as is.

It was reported there are 11 candidates in the Owen Sound radio class and the same number in the Pt. Elgin group. Both classes are progressing well.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion by Bill NEG. All in attendance were keenly interested in the fine video recordings captured by Jim BFV of the Discovery Orbiter and the performance of the astronauts as they ~~circled~~ orbited the earth.
