VE3OSR REPEATER

A lengthy and full discussion was held regarding ownership of the repeater. It was generally agreed that Club representatives rather than one person should have access to the equipment to make repairs, future changes, etc.

It was moved by Norm MTV that Club call VE3OSR be transferred from custodian Jim CRV to Henry TTV; motion seconded by Gene IJD and carried.

Tom TSA will make the necessary application with the D.O.C. for the change. He will also donate to the Club some repeater equipment necessary in the event Jim CRV removes that which he owns. Rick HIO will purchase additional equipment that may be necessary and have all items ready for installation.

It was moved by Gene IJD that up to \$200.00 be made available to Rick HIO from Club funds for the purchase of repeater equipment.

It was agreed that Tom NEM will assist in drafting a letter to Jim CRV explaining our intentions and thanking him for his past services, the letter to be signed by the President.

AMATEUR RADIO INSTRUCTION

The Owen Sound course is well under way with 5 sessions now completed on such subjects as basic electronics, feed lines, propagation, etc. There are 10 in the class; 7 from Owen Sound, 2 from Durham and one from Hepworth. Student visits to typical shacks were offered by Norm MTV, Tom TSA, JackDTS and Jim BFV. The course will run until mid May.
